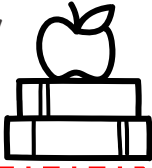

STUDENTS ABSENCES

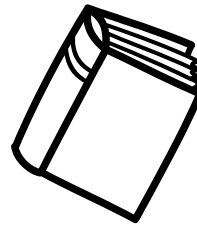
