

# Career Investigation Dodecahedron

Directions: A dodecahedron has twelve sides. You are going to create one about a career that you are interested in. You may use any of the templates provided, but you need to make sure you have the following information on at least one side of your project. In total you need to make sure you have 12 sides completed before you begin assembling your project together.

Sides to Include:

1. Job Description (at least 1 paragraph)
2. Duties and Responsibilities (3 to 5 for each one)
3. Job Outlook/Salary (In Kansas and Nationally)
4. Entry Level and Advanced Level Positions (at least 3 jobs positions total)
5. Career Goals (What goals do you have that can help you in reaching your goal of having this career as your job? Meed at least 2 goals)
6. Career Cluster: What Career Cluster does your career fit into?
7. Working Conditions (2 to 3 places/or general conditions)
8. Colleges and Majors (2 majors that relate to your career and at least one college with that major in the state of Kansas)
9. Job Title (Career)
10. How it relates to your interests
11. And 12. Pictures (2 sides of your project)

Tips: Create all of your sides first. They need to be very detailed, easy to read and pleasing to the eye. (Writing in pencil on all 12 sides is not "pleasing to the eye). When all sides are complete, cut each side out.

To Assemble Dodecahedron: (Use glue or rubber cement to put all 12 sides together)

1. Start with one side, glue 5 pieces to that one. One side on each of the five sides of your beginning piece. Complete this twice so you have two sections with six pieces each.
2. Attach the five outside pieces to each other to create a bowl shape. Complete with other side as well to then form two bowls.
3. Attach the 2 large sections together with glue, making sure to attach each piece to a new piece and work your way around.

\*Flaps may be on the outside or inside of your dodecahedron\*
